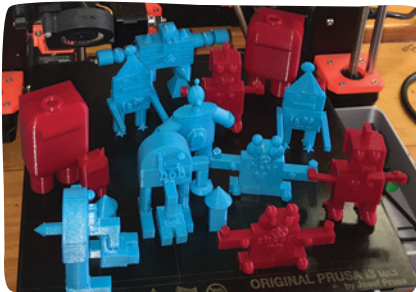
Tech Tournament Winner
